



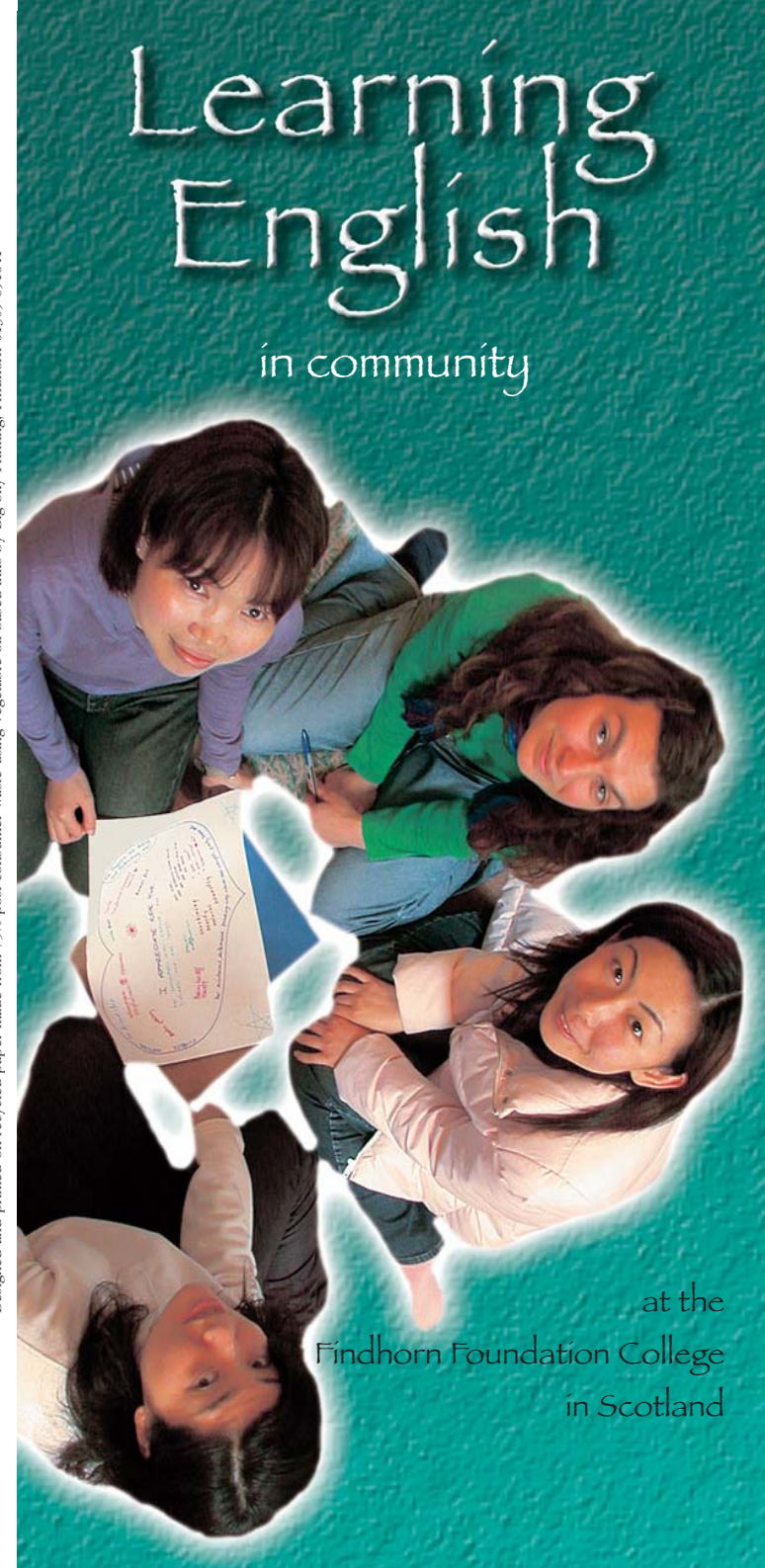

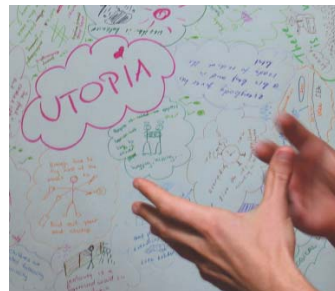

# Learning English in community

If you would like to learn English while you experience living in community at the Findhorn Foundation, this course offers you a unique opportunity. Many people discover that living here in community is a powerful and transformative experience and a turning point in their lives. And if you want to stay longer with us, then Learning English in Community allows you to go on to participate in other programmes and to continue to practice your English!

## The Programme

This full immersion programme provides a holistic learning environment in which body, mind and soul interact creatively to build language and interpersonal skills. You'll spend the mornings in a classroom setting with tuition by qualified and experienced *English as a Foreign Language* teachers. Outside the classroom you'll have time for self-study and opportunities to improve your conversation skills. The programme includes working with community members in areas such as the gardens and kitchens, and participating in group-building activities, presentations, and outings into the beautiful Scottish countryside. For all these reasons, the programme is fully residential and a non-residential option is not available.



## Community Life

Our multinational community provides a rich environment for increasing cultural awareness and exchange. During your free time and at weekends you'll have the option of a range of community activities such as celebrations, music and dance, meditation, sauna, and walks in nature.

(Some optional activities may carry an extra cost.)

## Programme Dates

The programme runs 3 or 4 times each year.

Prices are available on request and include tuition, extra activities, all meals (vegetarian) and shared accommodation.

Bursaries may be available.
